**Rule Book for All Pulls**

**General Rules**

1. Everyone will be charged admission to the fairgrounds, including pull participants.
2. No alcoholic beverages are permitted on the fairgrounds.
3. All pullers must sign a waiver of liability. The Fair Association is not liable for accidents or injuries.
4. All pulling vehicles will be one entry per class to be determined by lottery draw picked by registration officials.
5. All pulling vehicles will be weighed in for class and hitch checked to remain in staging area no allowance.
6. All pulling vehicles over 30% factory R.P.M.s must have side shields and bell housing protection.
7. All pulling vehicles will be subject to a random tech inspection.
8. No excess speeding or horseplay in the pit area.
9. Only officials, sled operator and pullers are permitted on the track.
10. Any disputes will be between the puller and the Contest Committee only.
11. Contest Committee has the right to reject any or all entries and/or change the rules.
12. Contest Committee has the right to add weight or start class over.
13. All entry fee refunds or prize money must be picked up that night or will be forfeited.

**Hooking and Unhooking**

1. The flagman will start and finish all hooks.
2. All pulling vehicles must remain in neutral while hooking and unhooking.
3. All pullers will have a 3-minute time limit to hook.
4. All pullers will have two attempts to start sled from tight hitch no jerking.
5. No portion of pulling vehicle shall interfere with sled or hitch during a pull.

**Pulling**

1. Full pull line will be determined by the committee.
2. First puller is test puller with option to come back for a re-hook last. If the sled is reset the first puller can not drop unless the class restarts.
3. Driver must remain seated with one hand on the wheel at all times.
4. All drivers are responsible for their own equipment.
5. Any loss of equipment or weights while hooked to sled and under the green flag will result in disqualification.
6. First puller disqualification will void the option for repull.

**Stock Garden Tractor Rules**

1. Must be minimum of 10 years of age.
2. Must wear helmet in youth class.
3. Pump gas only, no racing fuel or alcohol. No higher than .750 specific gravity.

4. No duals, studs or chains with tire size 23×10.50×12.
5. Stock tractors must be manufacturer's model.
6. Hitch height of 10".
7. No cut tires.
8. 4000 RPM limit will be checked randomly.
9. 14 horsepower, single cylinder standard O.E.M. stroke.
10. 20 foot safety zone for checking anything.
11. Intake runners stock length, no spacers or adapters. 1" maximum venture bore no velocity stacks.
12. Tractors must have wheelie bars that will support weight of tractor.
13. Flywheels must be shrouded 360 degrees, clutches 180 degrees.
14. Youth classes may have only ONE coach on the track.

#### Description

Standard tractor with two drive wheels will be supplied. Tractor is hitched to a special weight transfer sled. Sled has a weight box to which weights are added as needed.

1. Competition by ages 3 through 10 years.
2. Boys and Girls pull against each other by age.
3. Distance each contestant pulls the weight sled is measured and recorded.
4. Weight is added to sled as required to determine each category winner.
5. No use of hands to roll rear tires.
6. All movement of tractor must be forward by pedaling (leg power only).
7. No backing up and snatching of slide.
8. Disqualification for feet or foot being removed from pedals or touching surface of track.
9. Winners of each class pulls the most weight the longest distance by pedaling tractor and weight slide plus weights, the longest distance.
10. Pull-off will be held when two or more contestants perform a full pull. Additional weight will be added to transfer sled.
11. Judge's decisions are final.
12. PARENTS OF CONTESTANTS MUST REGISTER AND SIGN A WAIVER OF LIABILITY FOR THEIR CHILD.
13. Only contest helpers, the puller and puller's parents permitted on Track during pull. Photographers will also be permitted on Track, with the approval of the superintendent.

#### Street Gas Rules

1. No weights on front end or in cab. Weights must be secured on vehicle.
2. All vehicles must have current license and inspection.
3. Ring or clevis hitch set at 26" and 4" hole. No ball hitch.
4. No modifications to engine except air cleaner and headers.
5. Dual wheels okay. D.O.T. tires 36" maximum.
6. No rigid suspension, bump stops, spring clamps or traction bars.
7. 75 foot safety zone for changing anything.

8. All hitches must be at the most rearward part of vehicle.
9. Must have O.E.M. engine, interior and frame.
10. Drivers must have valid driver's license.

### 8500 2.5 Diesel 4x4 Trucks

### 8500 Pure Street Diesel

1. Must run factory size exhaust. Must exit under truck behind rear tire or through bed vertically. No hood stacks.
2. Must pull off of factory Reese style hitch. No pulling from bumper.
3. May use aftermarket air intake.
4. A total of three visual modifications allowed.
5. Must run D.O.T tires.
6. Must be licensed and inspected.
7. No front end weights. Weights must be securely fastened in bed. No weights inside of cab or engine compartment.
8. No propane, water injection or nitrous.
9. No heavy front bumpers. Lower front snow plow frame will be permitted. Discretion of legal bumper is up to track official.
10. 26" hitch height.
11. No suspension modifications are permitted. No traction bars are permitted. Suspension must have a minimum of two inches of downward movement at all times. No blocks are allowed between axle housing and truck frame that would restrict the necessary two inches of movement.
12. If the truck has airbags, the air line must be removed.
13. Transmission, transfer case and front and rear differentials must be O.E.M. and available in one ton (or smaller) pick-up trucks.
14. Truck must be pure stock in appearance – the condition the truck left the showroom floor when purchased by first owner. Bed floor, inner and outer skins must be O.E.M. or O.E.M. replacement material. Design modifications to reduce weight are not permitted. The wheelbase may not be changed from original manufacturer. Wooden or metal flatbeds are permitted as long as the bed is built to specification similar or heavier to factory built flatbeds.
15. Trucks may not be trailered in.

### Modified Street Gas Rules

1. Ring or clevis hitch set at 26" and 4" hole. No ball hitch.
2. Must have O.E.M. driveline, frame and engine.
3. Maximum tire size 36". Dual wheels allowed.
4. A recommendation of drive shaft loops – 2 per rear, 1 front.
5. 75 foot safety zone for changing anything.

**Farm Stock Tractor Rules**

1. Tractors with rubber tires, no duals, no 4-wheel drive, tire studs or chains (except unlimited)
2. Single turbocharger with no larger than 3" in and 3" out.
3. Drawbar height to be 20" length, 24" from center of axle, no loose hanging or top bracing.
4. Drawbar to be 1 inch thick no less than 1/2 inch, 4" diameter hole no more than 1 1/2 inch from back edge.
5. No pressurized tanks except LP gas.
6. Engine fans must be shrouded.
7. Exhaust must discharge upward above the highest point.
8. Weight bracket must be 11 ft from the center of the axle to the front of the weights.
9. All tractors must have hood and grill.
10. Maximum pace speed will be 3 miles per hour.
11. 60 foot safety zone for changing anything.
12. No front cut tires allowed such as tapering of cleat or extra ribs on cleat.
13. No top cut tires allowed from 14,000 pounds and up.
14. No water injection allowed.
15. One barrel up draft carburetor only.
16. If using a smaller diameter tire, one size wider is allowed.
